We would like to thank everyone for their very kind donations, it would not have been as successful as it was, without the help of all of you.



The World Goes Pop




On Monday 9th November 2015 the Art/ Photography and Textiles department visited the Tate Modern in London to experience 'The World Goes Pop' exhibition.
